What does the Jewish Tanakh consist of?

Torah: The 5 Books of Moses

Nevi'im: Prophets

Ketuvim: Writings

Note: This is an exercise for Jewish people to participate in who are not believers in Yeshua The Messiah, or as many call Him, Jesus.

The Goal of This Homework Assignment

To see how many Jews, including you, own and read the Tanakh on a regular basis. For if you read it, you would be Scripturally literate and informed about who the True Jew Messiah is for both the Jew and Gentile. The concept of Messiah is a "Jewish concept" and so it makes sense that one would want to read G-d's Word in order to investigate who G-d is and who the Messiah is that G-d has chosen to be the salvation for all mankind.

1. Write down the names of 10 Jewish people you know (including yourself).
 2. Put a check mark next in the TANAKH section for those who own a Tanakh.
 3. Put a check mark next to each section in regards to their reading regiment.
- *Exclude reading the Tanakh at a local Temple on Shabbat or on a high holiday.
*This is about if and when they read the Tanakh during their personal time only.
